¹ The minimum [CSULB Index](#) to be considered for Fall 2021 CSULB freshmen admission: Graduates of California high schools and other [California residents](#): 2.5 GPA or greater in college preparatory subjects, AND 3,200 minimum "CSULB Index" to be considered, for non-STEM major and a 3,600 minimum "STEM Index" for STEM majors. (Be aware this is higher than the minimum for CSU system-wide eligibility.)

VERIFICATION BY THE ATHLETIC DIRECTOR OR COACH:

Cal State University Long Beach is offering student athletes at your school the opportunity to take advantage of two major benefits for students who enter and remain in the Beach Crew rowing program (see above, “Verification by the Counselor”).

Besides getting a verification from the counselor, we are also asking that this student, who would like to take advantage of Preferred Admission at LBSU, obtain confirmation from their Athletic Director or coach, that they have participated in one or more Varsity Level sports for at least an entire year—preferably longer.

NOTE: Prior ROWING experience is not necessary to try out for the team. While an athletic background is certainly helpful, almost none of the current team members rowed before college. Our students come from several backgrounds including football, basketball, swimming, water polo, track, cross country, volleyball, soccer, lacrosse, softball, gymnastics, and tennis (also, a few of our students were not involved in athletics before college). While it can be an advantage to be tall in rowing, good competitive athletes come in all shapes and sizes. We certainly recruit for taller athletes, but a love of competition is required to row at LBSU, so if they are a smaller athlete with a strong will and a ton of determination to succeed they can certainly thrive on our team.
